Secondary Education courses that meet the CATC Thematic Core tags: EDUC 225 (SI) and EDUC 497 (with EDUC 135 taken at Wheaton) meets the PI theme. A maximum of 3 themes can count in both the major requirements and the general education requirements - for each major.

² The Spanish major requires an academic term abroad (semester or summer). Students may choose Wheaton In Latin America, Wheaton in México, Wheaton in Spain⁵ or another approved GPS program. See faculty advisor for more information on program specifics including coursework

³ Either SPAN 341^{F,1} or SPAN 342^{S,1} is required.

⁴ EDUC 324L and EDUC 305L are taken concurrently the semester prior to student teaching.

⁵ While EDUC 135, 136 and 136L need to be taken together, EDUC 101 can be taken separately. These courses should be complete during the first year.

⁶ EDUC 305 may be taken any semester after EDUC 225. It must be completed prior to student teaching.
