Curricular & Pedagogical changes:

Each year, in collaboration with Dr. Rob Ribbe, Director of HoneyRock and Rachael Cyrus, Director of Passage, we engage in a process of assessment and modifications to the curriculum and faculty training program for Wheaton Passage (CFM 131: Introduction to Spiritual Formation). This results in modifications to faculty supervision and training, student leader supervision and training, pedagogy for the course, reading assignments, grading procedures, and program assessment.

In collaboration with Justin Heth, Dean of Residence Life, and the Resident Directors of Wheaton College dormitories, significant modification occurs each year to the curriculum and pedagogy of CFM 333: Student Care in College Ministry. This course is the final component of an overarching training program for undergraduate Resident Assistants in the college dormitories.

I have added diversity readings to all courses as a result of assessments and increasing emphasis on the need for cultural competence in diverse cultural contexts.

I have modified the curriculum and pedagogy of a formerly shared core graduate course, Care & Counseling in Ministry, to align with the specific foci of the new M.A. programs in Outdoor Adventure Leadership and Higher Education & Student Development and to adapt to hybrid educational design.

I have incorporated new uses of technology in residential, modular, and hybrid courses.
