

The Class of '65 Global Health Internship Fund is available to Wheaton College students completing <u>for-credit internships</u> focused on Global Health. Qualified applicants must have "vocational interest in the field of global health and have financial need" and be enrolled as a Wheaton College student while completing the internship. This is a one-time award. If two students are determined to be equally eligible candidates, the award may be divided among both students. The experience may occur in Summer 2025 or Fall 2025.

## How to Apply

- 1. Complete the online Scholarship Registration Form (submit online: <u>https://form.jotform.com/250905809325156</u>)
- 2. Expanded Resume: This document aids the committee by providing a profile of your experiences (examples: volunteer and/or community service, research, shadowing/observation, employment, etc.). Please include the approximate hours (each week/month) for each experience. You are welcome to include activities that do not directly apply to medicine/healthcare. *Note: It can be longer than one page. Clear articulation of the responsibilities/skills of the experience is important.*
- 3. **Essay:** Please attach short description (paragraph) in which you share your interest, experience, and future goals within global health. Please list your planned or approved internship experience as well.

At the close of the internship, students will be asked to submit a summary of their internship experience to the Health Professions office to be forwarded to the donor.

Your materials should be submitted online by **Monday**, **April 21**, **2025**. If you have questions or need clarification, please contact the Health Professions Office well before the deadline.
