

EVP of Global Engagement

(Provided by 2024-25 Temporary Constitution)

A. Purpose.

- a. The primary role of the Executive Vice President of Global Engagement (EVPGE) shall be to facilitate exchanges between students, faculty, and the administration regarding the college's engagement with global issues. The EVPGE will also aid the Executive Director of Global Programs and Studies in developing the program of Global Programs and Studies.

B. Executive Authority.

- a. The goal of the EVPGE shall be to allow Wheaton students to pursue international connections that are in the interest of the college's Christ-centered mission. As such, s/he shall chair the Global Engagement Committee. The Global Engagement Committee shall be comprised of any student that the Executive Vice President may appoint. S/he will execute this goal through relationships and projects undertaken with
 - i. with other colleges and organizations, and
 - ii. within the Wheaton College community itself.
- b. This will be accomplished through proposals, events, and partnerships. Additionally, s/he will be responsible for representing students who have had extensive experience in a global setting, both to represent their needs to the administration and to formulate responses to those needs.

C. Communication Responsibilities.

a. Representation to the Administration

- i. Actively participate in administration affairs by attending meetings with the Executive Director of Global Programs and Studies (including their council).
- ii. Facilitate the discussion concerning unification of globally oriented programs under the Executive Director.
- iii. Actively participate in affairs regarding the International student community through regularly meeting with the Director of the International Student Programs office and student leaders of the International Student Programs Office.
- iv. Partner with Global Programs and Studies and International Students Program to plan, coordinate, facilitate and implement the annual International Education Week.

b. Representation to Students

- i. Attentively support and listen to interested student communities and bring their concerns to the Dean.
- ii. Gather a committee of students to support his/her efforts.

- iii. The EVPGE shall make regular reports to Student Government regarding the activities accomplished since the last report is given. In addition, the EVPGE will meet with the President and Vice President regularly.
- iv. In order to ensure accurate representation on Student Government the Global Engagement Committee shall invite participation as student liaisons from the following organizations:
 - 1. Representative from Axis
 - 2. Representative from Ladder Leaders
 - 3. Representative from MuKappa
 - 4. Representative from World Christian Fellowship
 - 5. Representative from International Apartments
- c. Representation to the Faculty
 - i. Attend all faculty business meetings.
 - ii. Attend faculty meetings that pertain to global and experiential learning.
 - iii. Attend Human Needs and Global Resources council meetings.
