

Undergraduate Special Student Summer School Application - 2026

INSTRUCTIONS—READ CAREFULLY

The Undergraduate Special Student Summer School Application form is to be completed by all persons who desire to take a summer course for credit but who are not enrolled in a degree program during the summer 2026 semester at Wheaton. A Special Student is non-degree seeking. If you plan to pursue a degree at Wheaton, you need to complete the regular application process through the Admissions Office rather than completing this form. If you are accepted as a special student and decide to seek a degree at a later date, the College is not obligated to accept you into a degree program. (NOTE: Students who wish to audit a course should use the Auditor Application.) In order to be considered an undergraduate special student for Summer 2026, the student must have graduated from high school prior to August 31, 2025.

Please note the following items:

- 1. Complete the application and sign the Community Covenant and Statement of Financial Responsibility forms below and return them to the Wheaton College Office of the Registrar. Applicants not currently enrolled at Wheaton must also include a \$50 deposit, unless applying to an off-campus program.
- 2. Send us your official college transcript. An official transcript is required for enrollment as a special student. Please have one sent immediately from a previous college, or from your high school if you have not previously attended college.
- 3. All application materials must be submitted no later than two weeks before the beginning of the class that you plan to take. You will not be registered for classes until these items have been received.
- 4. Make certain that you correctly list the course(s) you plan to take. One 4-credit course can be taken during each regular summer session. Only one course may be taken during a shortened special two-week session. Be certain that courses do not conflict. If credit is variable, indicate the amount of credit you desire. If no time is listed, the course will be taught on a TBA basis (to be arranged); you must obtain instructor approval to take the course.
- 5. Special students register after all degree students have registered and only for those courses which have not been filled. This means you should have more than one choice of courses when you arrive for registration.
- 6. Students who register for courses that note "Advance Preparation Required" must contact the sponsoring department for the preparation requirements.
- 7. If you indicate that you need campus housing, a copy of your form will be sent to the Housing Coordinator, who handles housing assignments. Questions related to housing should be directed to 630-752-5202.
- 8. We reserve the right to cancel any course that does not have sufficient enrollment (generally a minimum enrollment of 8 students is required). For us to have an accurate count for each course, we ask that you notify us immediately if your plans change. If you do not officially withdraw, you will be billed, and payment expected even if you do not attend the course for which you are registered.
- 9. Questions concerning any of the special programs should be directed to the Director of the program. This application is **REQUIRED** for registration **in addition** to the special program application you may have submitted to the program director. Study abroad programs may have additional requirements or prerequisites.
