

G.K. Chesterton Library

The Chesterton Library contains books that were owned by G.K. and Frances Chesterton, most obtained either from Chesterton bibliographer John Sullivan's collection, or Chesterton Studies Centre founder Aiden Mackey. Many of the books contain the Chestertons' personal library bookplate.

SIGNED: An * indicates that the book is signed by G.K. Chesterton. "Present'n copy" indicates the book was presented to Chesterton.

ANT: An * indicates that the book has been annotated.

Bolded text: Indicates the book is shelved by title
