

C.S. Lewis Library

Background Information

The majority of the Lewis Library was acquired from Wroxton College in 1986, where it had been in use by the patrons of the college library. Other titles have been given by C.S. Lewis's friends and associates to the Wade Center.

ANT: An * indicates that the book has been annotated. An annotation is considered a full sentence of text or more that is directly related to the *content* of the book.

MAR: An * indicates that the book has marginalia. Marginalia are defined as markings within the text comprising of less than a full sentence throughout the text, such as “?” or “!”. A “D” indicates that the book includes a Reading Date. An “I” indicates that a book includes an inscription of some sort, such as a presentation inscription or location, usually accompanying the signature and independent of the text of the book.

Bolded text: Indicates the book is shelved by title
