ARTICLE SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- 1. All submissions must be original contributions, previously unpublished (including on the web), and not under consideration by any other publisher at any time during the evaluation and publication process.
- 2. Submissions are generally 5,000 to 7,000 words, including endnotes (exceptions regarding word count are occasionally made).
- 3. Submit articles via email attachment, in Microsoft Word, to wade@wheaton.edu with "VII Submission [Title of paper]" in the subject line.
- 4. Since submissions will be blind-reviewed, the author's name and contact information should appear only on a removable cover sheet and author-identifying information in the text or references should be omitted.
- 5. Formatting should follow the *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers* (7th edition; 2009) or the *MLA Style Manual and Guide to Scholarly Publishing* (3rd edition; 2008). Please use intext parenthetical citation. You may choose to submit a paper that is not in MLA style; if it is accepted, you will be asked to alter it to conform to MLA.
- 6. The decision-making process generally takes 4-6 months.
- 7. If accepted for publication, we reserve the right to edit for usage and style. All accepted submissions are subject to editorial modification with permission of the author.
- 8. The author of an accepted article receives no financial remuneration, but does receive one complimentary copy of the volume in which his or her article appears, as well as a 50% discount when purchasing additional copies of that volume.
